Minutes Mead Public Library Board Strategic Planning Committee Wednesday, April 10, 2019

Finally, the group began working on the vision statement by writing down relevant words. The words that were brought up were:

Community anchor/anchor institution Heart of community Hub Vibrant Family oriented Welcoming place Recognized leader Respected voice Sheboygan area Cohesive Informed Innovative Imagination Aspire to be Relevant Engage(s)

For the next meeting, the group is tasked with thinking of ideas of what Mead's desired future state should be. This will help with wording the vision statement.
