ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION

2.1 Gen. Ord. No. 16 - 17 - 18 (6.4) by Alderpersons Schneider, Bohren and Belanger. An ordinance amending Chapter 70, Article VII, Division 2 of the Municipal Code so as to permit the discharge of weapons in certain rural portions of the City so that hunting may be permitted in those portions of the City where it would be appropriate, to ban the feeding of deer for hunting purposes or otherwise, and to bring the Municipal Code up to date with regard to various changes to state law related to the carrying of weapons. 2.2 Res. No. 71 - 17 - 18 (4.10) By Alderperson Donohue. A resolution establishing the 2018 Budget appropriations and the 2017 Tax Levy for use during the calendar year. A motion by Alderperson Holzschuh, seconded by Alderperson Damrow to recommend the Common Council accept the Police Department 2018 Budget. Motion carried. Planning Chad Pelishek presented his 2018 Building Inspection Budget. A motion by Alderperson Holzschuh, seconded by Alderperson Damrow to recommend the Common Council accept the Building Inspection Budget. Motion carried. Fire Chief Michael Romas presented his 2018 Fire Department Budget. He wished to include 3 firefighters and 1 battalion chief to the budget. A motion by Alderperson Holzschuh, seconded by Alderperson Damrow to recommend the Common Council accept the Fire Department Budget to include an amendment for an additional 3 firefighters and 1 battalion chief.
