R.O. No. 69 - 17 - 18 (6 - 19 - 17) Submitting various license applications for the period ending December 31, 2017 and June 30, 2019. Bev. Op. Lic. App. No. 1704 (Michael D. Elias)

Michael D. Elias failed to appear before the committee for a hearing on possible denial of his license application.

Motion by Alderperson Donohue, seconded by Alderperson Lewandoske, to deny the license application based upon Mr. Elias record of violations related to the licensed activity, his history as a habitual law offender, and his failure to cooperate with the committee. Motion carried 4 - 0.
