3.2 Update from Online Assessment sub-committee

Members Kate Hodges, Joe Kerlin and Abby Block shared progress on assessment thus far. The majority of the questions have been answered. For those that remain, the sub-committee requested assistance from the Survey group in querying the public.

A proposed event, Dogtoberfest, was discussed with the Task Group. To be held in conjunction with, and for the benefit of, the Humane Society of Sheboygan County, the event would allow dogs on the beach for the afternoon and offer vendors, information and activities. The discussed date was October 24 th. Joe Kerlin mentioned that it would require an ordinance change and would not officially get passed by the Common Council until October 19 th. Kate Hodges explained that there was another large event for the Humane Society that day, Subaru's Share the Love.
