



BACKGROUND / ANALYSIS:

Replacement of the Fleet Mechanics vehicle as well as that of the Communications and Electronics Technician was included in the 2017 budget along with a vehicle for the second CSO/Parking Enforcement Officer. A bid for all three of the trucks was received from Sheboygan Chevrolet found to be in compliance with all specifications and the lowest cost bid.
