AN ORDINANCE amending Subsection 26-554(4) of the Municipal Code relating to the fee for commercial plan review.

A RESOLUTION authorizing application for the 2015 Justice Assistance Grant Program Award (Local Solicitation) and entering into a Memorandum of Understanding with Sheboygan County.

WHEREAS, the City of Sheboygan and Sheboygan County have the opportunity to obtain a federal local solicitation grant in the total amount of \$15,183 funded through the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program, which is the primary provider of federal criminal justice funding to state and local jurisdictions, and

WHEREAS, in order to obtain the grant in the amount of \$15,183, it is necessary for the County to submit an application through the Justice Assistance Grant Award Program to be used for law enforcement equipment or resources and for the County to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with the City of Sheboygan for the sharing of grant proceeds and the equipment purchase therewith under terms similar to previous memoranda of understanding with the City of Sheboygan for previous similar grant award sharing, and

WHEREAS, the funding received would be 100% from federal sources with no state or local match requirement;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: That the City of Sheboygan Common Council authorizes the Mayor and Chief of Police to execute the 2015 Justice Assistance Grant Program Award Memorandum of Understanding between the City of Sheboygan and the County of Sheboygan, for the funds and equipment purchased therewith to be shared with the County of Sheboygan under terms similar to previous memoranda of understanding with Sheboygan County for previous similar grant award sharing.
