3.1 Com. No. 2 - 17 - 18 (4.1) Submitting a communication from 35 constituents from District Eight opposed to the Sheboygan County proposed non-motorized south side Utility Corridor Multi-Use Path in the Wisconsin Power and Light corridor between South 12 th Street and South 18 th Street.
