WHEREAS: The City Department of Public Works personnel have had demonstrations of both vehicles proposed and felt that overall the higher priced unit performed much better;

RESOLVED: That the Purchasing Agent is hereby authorized to enter into contract with Bruce Municipal Equipment of Menomonee Falls, WI for the purchase of one(1) 2016 Freightliner M2 single axle chassis , outfitted with an Elgin Brand Megawind® Vacuum Body at a total cost of \$250,918.00 and Title as per Bid # 1893-15 and;

Submitting a tabulation (attached) of Bid #1893-15 for the purchase of
(1) One single axle vacuum truck and related equipment as specified:

Bruce Municipal Equipment, Menomonee Falls WI

2015 Freightliner Model M2 equipped with an Elgin Megawind
Vacuum Body and related equipment.....\$ 250,918.00

Serwe Implement, Brownsville WI

2015 Freightliner Model M2 equipped with a Vac-All All Catch

After a thorough review of the bids submitted the following
recommendation is presented for award:

The truck offered with the **low bid** was found to be deficient in a number
of areas when compared against the specifications including:

- It does not have a separate engine for operation of the vacuum; a separate engine is required for proper performance and is much quieter than using the main truck engine.
- Deployment and stowing of the collection hose at the rear of the vehicle will require the use of a ladder creating additional worker safety concerns;
- While both trucks have the ability to operate at low speed while underway, the Vac All unit uses a special Hydrostatic drive system to propel the vehicle creating a potential maintenance issue;
- The thickness of the floor of the hopper in the lesser priced unit did not meet specification and such thinner metal has a tendency to rust through over time.
- The control of the hose and boom of the lower priced unit include a lesser degree of operability, requiring workers to position the unit using body strength and creating a potential for injury.
- The lower cost vehicle requires connection of a chain and use of the hose boom to open the rear gate for dumping, while the Elgin unit uses dedicated hydraulics as was specified.
- The Lower cost unit exhausts dust and purge air out of the top of the body where the Elgin unit exhausts to the rear, ultimately creating less ambient dust.
- The Lower cost Vac-All unit uses 6 removable filter screens which must be removed using tools for cleaning while the Elgin unit has just two hinged screens requiring no tools.
- The Vacuum hose assembly on the lower priced unit does not fold flat against the rear of the body, creating a protrusion hazard while the Elgin folds flat.
- The high pressure water system in the lower priced vehicle offers a strength of 175 psi, where the specification was 225 psi. The extra strength is required for dislodging debris while clearing catch basins, drain pits etc.

Sub Wks

- In checking with other municipalities, Vacuum units with a dedicated Diesel Engine to create vacuum far outperform those that utilize the main engine of the truck exclusively.

This piece of equipment is used for a variety jobs from the cleanout of storm sewer collector basins, drain pits and even leaf collection.

While the Elgin Megawind bid is higher, it is clearly the better unit for the City of Sheboygan when compared against the specifications. These specifications were written to accommodate all of the current needs of the Department of Public Works, meant to maximize up-time of the vehicle and to assure that the safety of the workers is protected.

The recommendation therefore is to award the bid to Bruce Municipal Equipment in the amount of \$ 250,918.00 for the purchase of the Freightliner Chassis and Elgin Megawind Equipment.

WHEREAS: The City of Sheboygan contracts annually for the treatment required to eliminate tree roots in the City sewer network and;





WHEREAS, there is limited dedicated park space available for the same.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: That the City of Sheboygan provide park areas designated as "pet friendly areas."
